DIRECTIONS

From East

SPEAKER BIOS

John-Michael Keyes

Director of The "I Love U Guys" Foundation

John-Michael Keyes presents The "I Love U Guys" Foundation to schools, police departments, fire departments, and organizations regarding school safety. His professional career has included graphic design, software development, and work flow analysis. The death of his daughter, Emily, at Platte Canyon High School, Bailey, CO. compelled Mr. Keyes to bring his professional expertise to the arena of school safety.

The "I Love U Guys" foundation is introducing The Standard Response Protocol (SRP). SRP is based not on individual scenarios, but on the response to any given incident. With a combination of humor and heart, the presentation includes powerful reminders of the importance of school safety planning, building partnerships with law enforcement, and recognizing that no school is immune to emergency events. This is a must see presentation!

Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA)

Agents Carvelli and Muniz are assigned to the Boston Diversion Group. They investigate and prevent the movement of controlled substances and listed chemicals from the legal market to the illegal market. This presentation will provide School Resource Officers, Detectives and School Officials an update on drug trends, illicit drug use, over-the-counter medications and prescription medications. Learn how high school students are gaining access to these illicit drugs and how it's affecting our schools. While use of gateway drugs remains relatively constant, over-the-counter and prescription drug use continue to increase.
